

Objective

BESST is a research retreat of the Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Sciences. The aim is to improve connections between researchers and research topics at the faculty. It is about strengthening exchange and collaboration in research and thus increasing quality and impact.

Target group

All faculty researchers are cordially invited to attend and engage in the discussions.

Short presentations may be given by professors, academic counselors, lecturers, habilitation candidates and postdocs – including as joint presentations with doctoral candidates.

Topics

Ideally, contributions should relate to projects or ideas that are currently in preparation or that you would like to further develop in the future. The aim is not to present published work, but rather to foster discussion about potential future (joint) projects. We invite you to submit contributions aligned with the three Focus Areas of our faculty:

- Digital Transformation and Change
- Sustainable Economy and Consumption
- Inequality and Diversity

We also welcome contributions that cannot be specifically assigned to these Focus Areas. Topics such as computational science, data science, finance, health, public administration or other areas of research are equally encouraged. Anything that the faculty members are researching is interesting!

Formats

Please note that the retreat will be held in English. All contributions are to be submitted and presented accordingly.

Short presentations followed by a discussion are highly encouraged (e.g. 15 min. presentation + 15 min. discussion; please let us know if you have other requests). Presentations may take various forms, with the support of slides or flipcharts, a software demonstration or even pantomime, etc.

A panel discussion on **Open Sience** will take place in the afternoon. Our confirmed speakers include Dean **Jörg Schiller**, **Ulrike Fasbender**, **Adrian Lüders** and **Henner Gimpel**. An additional speaker from KIM is to be announced.

Guest speakers whose work aligns with our thematic focus areas are also a great addition.
