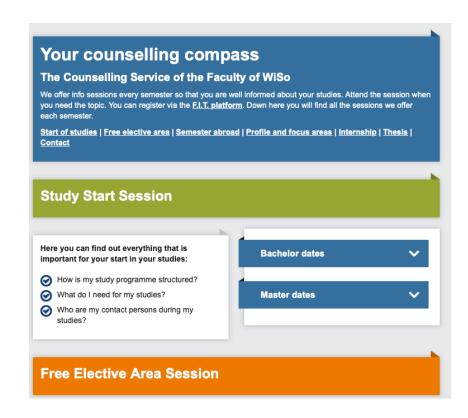

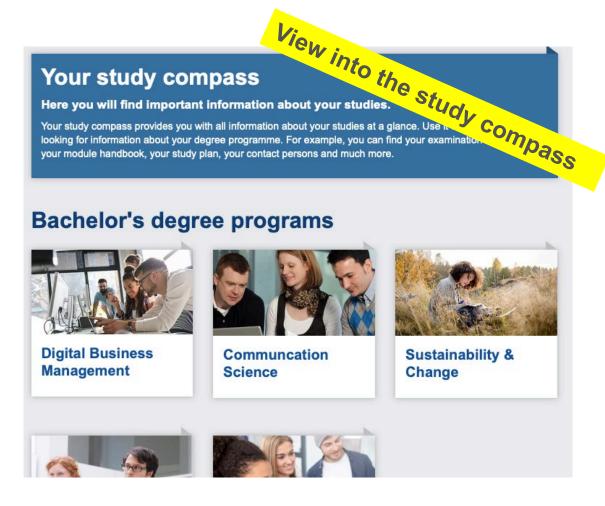

The examination regulations contain all legal regulations regarding examinations. In the module catalog you will find all the modules that you must or can take in your studies. The study plan shows the modules in the individual semesters in chronological order. Read through everything at the beginning of your studies so that you are well informed about your options in your studies. This is your tool to plan your studies from the beginning.

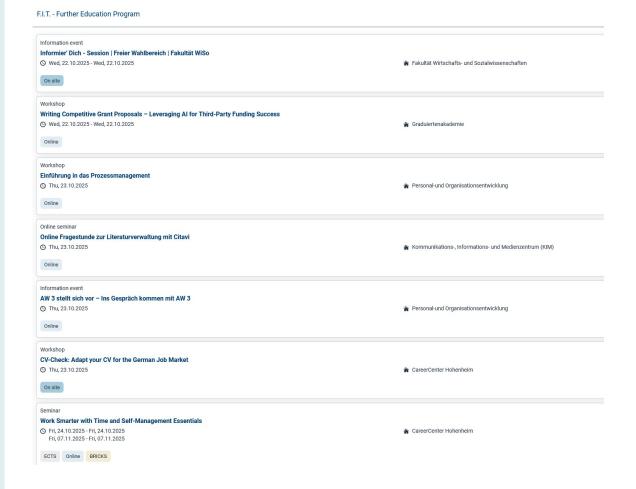

INTERNSHIP

INTERNSHIP MODULE IN BACHELOR

UNGRADED MASTER PORTFOLIO MODULE IN MASTER'S DEGREE

Prerequisite:

- Company internship of at least 5 weeks, continous and full-time.
- Working student activities that meet the requirements of the internship and are performed full-time (e.g. during semester breaks)
- Working student activities that are proven over at least five months with at least 10 hours of working time per week.

INTERNSHIP MODULE IN BACHELOR

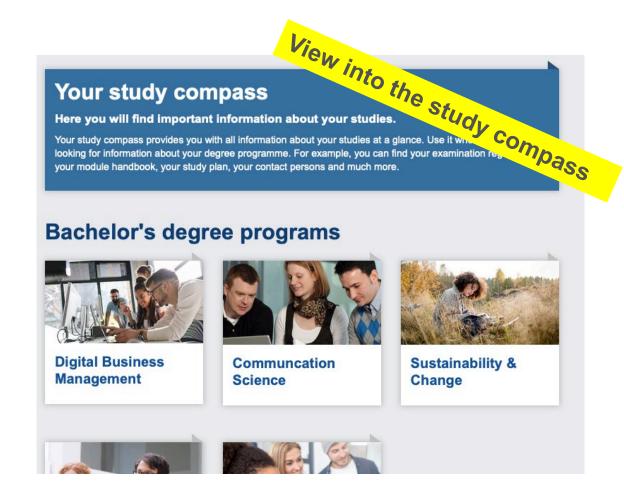
UNGRADED MASTER PORTFOLIO MODULE IN MASTER'S DEGREE

Evidence:

- Written internship report of 5-10 pages and an internship confirmation/certificate.
- The internship report consists of three parts:
 - Presentation of the company
 - Activity report about the tasks during in the internship
 - Conclusion/Resumé

- GRADED VS. UNGRADED (MASTER) PORTFOLIO MODULE

- Cerificates of all courses to be credited
- Binding registration in HohCampus before submitting the documents, which cannot be cancelled (Communication Science!)

WHAT ELSE IS THERE TO CONSIDER?

- Certificates can be collected until the end of the study program
- ECTS credits do not expire
- No choice, whether graded or ungraded
- In the grade report it says "Graded portfolio module" or "Ungraded portfolio module".

THE ADDITIONAL AREA

WHAT IS THE ADDITIONAL AREA?

- Modules can be taken additionally in the course of study
- Do not count toward degree or average grade
- Must be registered in the additional area in HohCampus
- Module title and grade appear in the additional area in certificate on request
 - > Then application for "issuance of the certificate" must be made
