



Doctoral Seminar - Winter Semester 2022/23

Course Description:

In this doctoral seminar, doctoral students (as well as post-docs) from the University of Hohenheim can present their ongoing work and get feedback from other doctoral students and faculty members. Presented work can either be empirical or theoretical, but should have an economic focus. Note that the emphasis of this seminar is on informal debate and an exchange of views and ideas. The presentation of preliminary research ideas is just as welcome as the presentation of full-fledged papers. This seminar can also act as a platform to prepare doctoral students for a conference presentation or for their thesis defense. Finally, we hope that, with this seminar, students and faculty members will have a better notion of the research taking place in our faculty.

Modalities:

The doctoral seminar will take place as a brown bag seminar on Tuesdays during the winter semester between 18:00 and 20:00. Presentations will take place in the seminar room of the Institute for Health Care and Public Management (Fruwirthstraße 48, 1st floor). Please note that the university's hygiene guidelines must be adhered to at all times. A detailed program will be drafted before the beginning of the semester.
